 - 2025: Cisco, Stacklok, Linux Foundation, Red Hat, Double Open ?
- Key result 2: Double community contributions on GitHub by end of the year
- 2. Work closely together with various other organizations, including the ORT, TODO Group, OSPO++, OSPO Alliance, OpenChain, SPDX, OWASP Foundation, GUAC, Eclipse Foundation, and Software Heritage, to promote ClearlyDefined. Work closely together with OpenSSF.
- Key result 1: Triple the number of organizations we are involved with
 - 2023: OpenChain, ORT (uses harvest data), Scancode (Roman from GitHub working with them)
 - 2024: +OpenSSF/GUAC
 - \circ 2025: Eclipse Foundation (definition, curation), OWASP, Software Heritage, TODO Group
- Key result 2: Increase activities (webinars, events, blog posts, social media, PRs) with various organizations by 100%
