AI contributions

- Clarify:
 - Policy around contributions / use of AI
 - Bot and data scraping policy
- Existing policies from other projects:
 - AI-generated or AI-assisted contributions are mostly permitted.
 - Recommends “Assisted-by:” or “Generated-By:” labels in commit message.
 - Human in the loop: contributors remain responsible for ensuring submitted content is correct, secure, and compatible with the project's licensing requirements.

- Recommendation
 - Work together with AboutCode and adopt same policy, update [CONTRIBUTING.md](#) and create AGENTS.md



AI contributions

Proposal:

- Human in charge (responsible for contributions + discussions)
- ML tools can assist, not author
- Disclosure is required
- This will be enforced



Data curation meetings

- Eclipse Foundation recommends better engagement with ClearlyDefined
- In particular, around data curation
- Philippe recommends setting meetings around data curation
- Align with data curators at Microsoft (Candice and Ariel), and others:
 - Ria (HPE)
 - Marek (Red Hat)
 - Joshua (Verizon)
 - Shawn, Wayne, Rahul, Boris (Eclipse)
 - Henrik Sandklef (AboutCode)
- Start meetings in September
